SACSSGSA SWIMMING CARNIVAL RULES

- IN EXTENUATING, EMERGENCY OR UNFORSEEN CIRCUMSTANCES, THE CARNIVAL CONVENOR HAS SOLE DISCRETION TO MAKE CHANGES TO THE CARNIVAL RULES
- <u>CHANGE OF NOMINATIONS</u> Any changes that need to be made on the day must be received by Meet Manager Administrator or Meet Convenor no later than 1.40pm.
- No new nominations will be accepted after this time unless a school has a swimmer already allocated and said swimmer cannot swim for some reason. A replacement may be made only through the Call Room Manager at least 5 events before the time the replacement swimmer has to swim. This replacement can only be made by the schools team manager wearing their school name badge.
- <u>OFFICIALS</u>: Each school will be asked to supply 2 officials 1 timekeepers and maybe 1 other Official. Whilst we have limited assistance from Swim SA and/or Club officials this does <u>NOT</u> cover all the required positions to be filled. therefore, it is imperative that all schools accept their responsibility in providing the officials required. **Please note that the timekeeper role can be filled by a responsible Senior Student.*
- <u>COMPETITORS</u>: AGE Taken from January 1st in year of competition.
- <u>NUMBER OF EVENTS</u>: A swimmer may swim in a maximum of 4 events, including a Freestyle Relay; PLUS, a swimmer may swim in a maximum of 3 OPEN events.

- Swimmers may swim up an age group but not in the same stroke. That is, U14 Freestyle and U15 Backstroke are allowed. U14 Freestyle and U15 Freestyle are NOT allowed. A swimmer may swim in U15 50m Freestyle and OPEN 50m Freestyle. However, a swimmer may swim an age group stroke and repeat that stroke in the Medley events.
- There are 3 Divisions in U13 and 16+ age groups and 2 Divisions in U14, U15, U16 age groups. The exception to this is that 50m Freestyle has 4 Divisions per age group.
- All OPEN events have 2 Divisions, with the exception of the OPEN Medley and the Age Group Freestyle Relays, where there is only 1 Division.
- <u>MARSHALLING</u>: The time factor for starting events will be strictly followed. Events <u>will not</u> be held up for competitors who are not present. Events start promptly at 2.00pm and competitors must be at the pool no later than 1.15pm. To avoid congestion in the change room, please come changed in track suits or warm clothing. Warm up commences at 1.30pm for 20 mins.
- Lockers are not available so please do not leave valuables (money, watches etc.) in the change rooms. Competitors in the first 10 events will be called up for lane allocation at 1.50pm. Report to the Starting Marshall when your event is called. Failure to answer the call will mean you are not eligible to swim in that event. When allocated, remain in line (per lane order) until marshalled to the check starter.
- <u>START:</u> When your event is announced wait for the announcer's introduction then move forward on to the side of the starting block and await the starter's orders. Step on to the starting block when called by the starter or enter the water as is required for backstroke- stand so that your heels are at the back of the block listen for the starters gun and move only when it sounds. The meet is conducted under the **"one start rule".**
- <u>FINISH:</u> After completion of the race, remain in the water in your lane until the <u>CHIEF JUDGE</u> tells you to leave the pool by blowing the whistle. Please exit at the side of the pool near lanes 0 and 9.
- <u>RELAYS</u>: Four swimmers in each event. In the medley, the order is: Backstroke, Breaststroke, Butterfly, and Freestyle. Number 1 and 3 start at shallow end, and 2 & 4 at the deep end. Students must follow the same procedure for checking in as individual events all 4 swimmers MUST present together and provide names to be checked off. Marshalls will then take you to your correct starting location poolside.
- Individual Medley Relay: The order is: Butterfly, Backstroke, Breaststroke, Freestyle.
- <u>BATHERS:</u> It is a Swim SA ruling that <u>ONE PIECE BATHERS BE WORN</u> in competition. We suggest a T-shirt or rash top be worn over their bathers if your students do not own a one-piece costume. Bathing caps are optional. Please bring warm clothing to put on in between events.
- <u>REPRESENTATIVES</u>: Each school should appoint their own <u>OFFICIAL REPRESENTATIVE</u> to query any decisions with the Carnival Chief Referee on the night if necessary.
- <u>RESULTS:</u> FULL results will be posted to schools as soon as possible. Record breakers will be issued with a certificate. The Shield for the overall Aggregate, Senior and Junior will be presented at the end of the Carnival where possible.
- <u>CHEER SQUADS</u>: We thoroughly commend these but PLEASE seat yourselves so that you do not disrupt the marshal or starter. Remain <u>SILENT UNTIL THE RACE HAS COMMENCED. NO PAPER STREAMERS PLEASE</u>.
